

The Governor noted that Virginia will enter phase one starting as soon as next week, but today's (4.5.20) briefing will serve as an outline of these steps:

Phase One includes the following:

- Safer at home
- No social gatherings of more than ten individuals
- Continued social distancing
- Continued teleworking
- Face coverings recommended in public
- Easing limits on business and faith communities

The Governor noted that Phase 1 could last two to four weeks, and measures include physical distancing, enhanced cleaning and disinfection. The Governor noted that his administration will be publishing guidelines. He noted that during phase one, restaurants can re-open but with limited seating, salons and barbershops will operate only with an appointment, and gyms will re-open but with limited capacity.

The Governor noted that **Phase II** includes the following:

- No social gatherings of more than fifty individuals
- Continued social distancing
- Continued teleworking
- Face coverings recommended in public

The Governor noted he will extend Executive Order 53, which closed certain facilities such as salons, and other non-essential businesses, through 14 May 2020. The current Stay-at-Home-Order will be adjusted to be "Safer-at-Home" than "Stay-at-Home".
